Reorganizacija, ki se načrtuje med aprilom in majem, bo zaposlene notranje prerazporedila v nove delovne skupine, ki se bodo osredotočale na tri prioriteta področja: prosto dostopna znanost (open science), odprte inovacije (open innovation) in trajnostni razvoj (sustainable development). Osem glavnih delovnih skupin, se bo soredotočala na splošne, širše opredeljene teme:

- Planet I: oceani, zemlja, podnebne raziskave
- Planet II: energija in transport
- Ljudje: družbene vede in znanosti o življenju
- Blaginja: industrijske raziskave in naložbe
- Horizon 2020: načrtovanje
- Horizon 2020: implementacija
- Infrastruktura in skupnosti
- Inovativna administracija: proračun in logistika

Posebej se bo združilo pet skupin, ki bodo vodile nov pilotni projekt Evropski svet za inovacije.

Poleg tega bo del časa vsega osebja, namenjen iskanju povezav med obstoječimi deli programa Horizon 2020 in povezovanju z drugimi oddelki, programi Komisije.

Načrt vključuje tudi spremembo hierarhije, ter nekoliko znižuje število zaposlenih (iz 54 na 50).

Spremembe so pomembne, saj že dolgo ocene delovanja opozarjajo na preveč zapleteno birokratsko strukturo in nepovezanost tako znotraj Generalnega direktorata kot tudi s preostalimi deli Komisije. Prav tako jim je potrebno posvečati veliko pozornosti, saj je Generalni direktorat za raziskave in inovacije 5 največji znotraj Komisije, nadzoruje pa tretji največji progračun-Horizon 2020. Ta pa bo po novem predlogu Komisije, postal še večji.

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➤ **Evropski parlament je sprejel stališče za pogajanja o novem programu InvestEU**

Evropski parlament je sprejel stališče za pogajanje z državami članicami v okviru Sveta EU o programu InvestEU. Ta program InvestEU bo v finančnem obdobju 2021-2027 podpiral štiri glavna področja, in sicer trajnostno infrastrukturo; raziskave, inovacije in digitalizacijo; mala in srednja podjetja ter socialne naložbe in spretnosti. Pod eno streho bo program InvestEU združil vse finančne instrumente EU za podporo naložbam,

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➤ **MEDREGIJSKE INVESTICIJE V INOVACIJE 2021-2027 - Evropsko teritorialno sodelovanje – Komponenta 5**

Evropska komisija je v svojem novem predlogu o Kohenzijski politiki na področju Evropskega teritorialnega sodelovanja predlagala nov instrument, t.i. Interregional Innovation Investment ali t.i. "Komponento 5", ki je dodatna komponenta tradicionalnim Interreg instrumentom in ki bo spodbujala medregionalne naložbe v inovacije in tako spodbujala investicije blizu trga. V ospredju bi bile predvsem v nove tehnologije in procesi za inovativne izdelke in storitve, vse to na prioritetnih področjih evropskih verig dodane vrednosti. Fokus bi se prestavil iz faz učenja in povezovanja na faze demonstracije, komercializacije in povečanje obsega. Na pobudo Komisije, v skladu s točko 5, 3. člena, ERDF lahko podpira medregijske investicije v inovacije. Povezuje podjetja, civilno družbo in javni sektor, vse, ki so vpleteni v pametno specializacijo strategij na regioalnem in nacionalnem nivoju.

Instrument t.i. komponenta 5 naj bi podpirala medregionalne projekte, ki spodbujajo naložbe v inovacije, v demonstracijsko infrastrukturo, večjo dostopnost malim in srednje velikim podjetjem do novih raziskav in tehnologij, skratka instrument bo spodbujal projekte, ki imajo namen komercializirati nove inovacije, povečati njihov prodor na trg EU ter ustvarjanje novih verig vrednosti.

Predlagani proračun instrumenta »komponenta 5« je 970 milijonov EUR za obdobje 2021-2027, kar predstavlja približno 11,5% Evropskega teritorialnega sodelovanja. Za razliko od »klasičnih« interreg programov, bi naj upravljanje izvajanja t.i. komponente 5 potekalo centralizirano.

Polovica sredstev v komponenti 5 bo namenjena prvemu sklopu: Finančna in svetovalna podpora za investicije v medregijske projekte za inovacije, polovica pa drugemu sklopu: Finančna in svetovalna podpora za razvoj verig vrednosti v manj razvitih regijah.

Prvi sklop: Finančna in svetovalna podpora za investicije v medregijske projekte za inovacije, naj bi podpiral partnerstva podjetij, raziskovalnih organizacij, univerz, regionalnih in lokalnih skupnosti, ki bi povezovala ali dopolnjevala uporabo svojih testnih in demonstracijskih obratov ter s tem pospeševala komercializacijo inovacij in večji prodor na trg. Drugi sklop: Finančna in svetovalna podpora za razvoj

verig vrednosti v manj razvitih regijah je namenjen večanju zmogljivosti regionalnih inovacijskih ekosistemov v manj razvitih regijah ter s tem njihovo sodelovanje v svetovnih vrednostnih verigah ter boljše sodelovanje z drugimi regijami.

Ustvarjena bi bila tudi nova ekspertna skupina, ki jo bi sestavljali iz predstavniki držav članic, regij, EU institucij, stroke in drugih potencialno zainteresiranih strani. Ekspertna skupina bi svetovala Komisiji pri oblikovanju dolgoročnega delovnega programa in z njim povezanih razpisov. Razpisi bi bili odprti za vse vrste partnerstev, ki bi na določenem tematskem področju povezovali regijska partnerstva s prednostno nalogo pametne specializacije.

Evropski parlament – odbor za regionalni razvoj (REGI) je junija 2018 pooblastil poslanca Pascala Arimonta kot poročevalca za pripravo poročila o predlogu Komisije o teritorialnem sodelovanju po letu 2021. Poročilo, pripravljeno 26. julija 2018, predlaga številne dopolnitve predloga Evropske komisije o Evropskem teritorialnem sodelovanju (ETC). Ti predlogi so med drugim:

- Večina sredstev ETC (74,8%) naj bo namenjeno čemejnemu sodelovanju
- Pomorsko sodelovanje naj bo vključeno v čezmejno sodelovanje
- Medregionalne naložbe v inovacije (komponenta 5) naj ne zmanjša proračuna drugih komponent ETC, ampak naj se raje za to komponento zagotovijo dodatna sredstva (dodatnih 0,3 % kohezijskih sredstev)
- Več sredstev za prve štiri komponente ETC

Arimontovo poročilo je bilo 3. decembra potrjeno na parlamentarnem odboru za regionalni razvoj, 16. januarja 2019 pa še na plenarnem zasedanju.

Ker temeljne in potencialno prelomne raziskave, ki lahko spodbudijo mlade, da postanejo raziskovalci, niso dovolj znane, so se partnerji v evropskem projektu SCIENCESQUARED odločili jih prek multimedijskih kampanj predstaviti. Eden od partnerjev v projektu je Evro-sredozemska univerza (EMUNI), ki ima sedež v Portorožu. Razvili so različna orodja, s katerimi so prenesli raziskave iz laboratorijev v javni prostor. Med njihovimi aktivnostmi je tudi organizacija komunikacijskih

usposabljanj za prejemnike podpor Evropskega raziskovalnega sveta (ERC) kot pomoč pri predstavljanju njihovega dela javnosti.

Omogočili so, da so državljani lahko v njihovem materinem jeziku prek zgodb, delavnic in drugih dogodkov v prirodoslovnih muzejih, trgovskih centrih in na znanstvenih festivalih in na drugih javnih mestih spoznavali, kako zanimiva je lahko znanost.

Aktivnosti so izvajali o različnih znanstvenih temah, ki so jih menjavali na šest mesecev. Za vsako temo so uporabili različen pristop. Za predstavitev znanstvenih dosežkov na področju hrane so recimo organizirali prireditve z okušanjem in preprostimi poskusi.

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➤ **Članice EU so se zavezale, da bodo prekinile medsebojne dvostranske naložbene pogodbe v EU**

Države članice EU so se na podlagi lanske sodbe sodišča EU v zadevi Achmea zavezale, da bodo prekinile vse medsebojne dvostranske naložbene pogodbe v EU. V zadevi Achmea je Sodišče EU presojalo o investicijskem sporazumu med Nizozemsko in Slovaško s katerim sta se dogovorili, da bosta spore, ki se lahko nanašajo na uporabo ali razlago prava unije, izvzeli iz pristojnosti svojih sodišč. To ni v skladu s pravom EU. Zaveze bodo po zagotovilih Evropske komisije vlagateljem in arbitražnim sodiščem do prekinitve dvostranskih naložbenih pogodb zagotovile dodatno pravno varnost.

S tem, ko sta Slovaška in Nizozemska spore, ki se lahko nanašajo na uporabo ali razlago prava unije, izvzeli iz pristojnosti svojih sodišč, sta jih izvzeli tudi iz ureditve pravnih sredstev, ki jo morajo v skladu s pogodbo EU vzpostaviti na področjih, ki jih ureja pravo Unije. Iz teh razlogov je sodišče odločilo, da sta Slovaška in Nizozemska s sklenitvijo sporazuma vzpostavili mehanizem za reševanje sporov, s katerim ni mogoče zagotoviti, da bo o teh sporih odločalo sodišče iz sodnega sistema unije, pri čemer lahko le tako sodišče zagotovi polno učinkovitost njenega prava. V teh okoliščinah arbitražna klavzula iz sporazuma posega v avtonomijo prava unije in zato ni v skladu z njim.

Takšnih sporazumov, kot sta ga sklenili Slovaška in Nizozemska, imajo države članice EU med seboj sklenjenih okrog 200. Za te sporazume so se zavezale, da jih bodo prekinile. To pa ne pomeni, da bodo vlagatelji ostali brez pravnega varstva. Po razlagi Evropske komisije pravo EU določa zaščito vseh vlagateljev EU proti nezakonitemu poseganju držav članic, kar zagotavlja njihovo enako obravnavo. Zaveze bodo po zagotovilih Evropske komisije vlagateljem in arbitražnim sodiščem do prekinitve dvostranskih naložbenih pogodb zagotovile dodatno pravno varnost, prav tako pa naj bi preprečile nove arbitražne odločbe in postopke, ki ne bi bile v skladu s pravom EU.

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### ➤ EU bo z 20 milijoni evrov podprla oblikovanje nove platforme umetne inteligence na zahtevo

Evropska unija bo z 20 milijoni evrov podprla oblikovanje nove platforme umetne inteligence na zahtevo. Ta mesec se uradno začne projekt AI4EU, ki združuje 79 vrhunskih znanstvenih ustanov, malih in srednje velikih podjetij ter velikih podjetij iz 21 držav, da bi oblikovali enotno točko za dostop do virov umetne inteligence. Na platformi bodo na voljo podatkovne zbirke, računalniška zmogljivost, orodja in algoritmi. Uporabniki bodo lahko testirali tehnologijo ter jo vključevali v rešitve umetne inteligence za svoje procese, proizvode in storitve. Člani lahko na SBRA dobijo dodatne informacije.

Platforma bo ponudila tudi tečaje za dodatno izobraževanje in prekvalifikacijo. Projektna ekipa AI4EU bo tesno sodelovala z vozlišči digitalnih inovacij za robotiko in mrežo centrov odličnosti za umetno inteligenco, ko bo ta vzpostavljena. EU bo projektu namenila 20 milijonov evrov za naslednja tri leta. Evropska komisija bo za naložbe v raziskave in inovacije na področju umetne inteligence na zahtevo v obdobju 2018–2020 v okviru programa Obzorje 2020 povečala na 1,5 milijarde evrov. Do konca leta 2020 pa naj bi skupne javne in zasebne naložbe v EU na tem področju dosegle vsaj 20 milijard evrov.

Članice EU so v letu 2017 za raziskave in razvoj namenile nekaj manj kot 320 milijard evrov, kar predstavlja 2,07 odstotka BDP. To je majhna rast glede na leto 2016, ko so vlaganja v raziskave in razvoj znašala 2,04 odstotka BDP. Leta 2007 so članice EU za tovrstna vlaganja namenile 1,77 odstotka BDP, v prvi oceni navaja evropski statistični urad Eurostat.
