The UniLiON Brokerage Event Task Team is planning to organise on **4th June 2019 a Brokerage Event** on **Horizon 2020 - Societal Challenge: Good security, sustainable agriculture and forestry, marine, maritime and inland water research and the bioeconomy**.

The idea is to have a **one day event** where the researchers from the **UniLiON universities** will have the opportunity to network, exchange ideas, and possibly create consortia in order to submit project proposals in the next call. The goal is to offer to the participants the chance to listen general and more specific info on the call, have a speaker delivering advice on how to structure/advice on the proposal, and then have the brokerage event.

Apart from university researchers, we also plan to invite external relevant stakeholders to participate to the event as possible partners/leaders.

What we ask from you is to disseminate this information to your researchers/academics that would be interested to come to Brussels and participate in this event.

Details on the event

We plan to focus on specific topics. Please find here the link to the topics. You can select the topic(s) that your researcher(s) is/are interested in.

Max 3 researches per university. The researchers would need to identify the topic and subtopic they are interested in.

Depending on the interest, we will focus in maximum 2 general topics.

The details of the programme are still under "construction". The event would look like roughly as it follows:

Morning

- 1) presentation of the calls and specifics of the topic (by an NCP tbc);
- 2) training session on the proposal preparation;

Lunch

Afternoon

- 3) Break-out sessions: sharing of ideas, shaping of a possible project proposal.

The deadline for submitting the expression of interest is **10th April 2019**. However, in case you will receive interest from your researchers after the deadline, this does not mean that they would be excluded. This is a preliminary search for researchers. **It is very important, nevertheless, to receive a first input before the 10th of April.**
