The scheme is open to researchers who have less than 10 years postdoctoral experience and who are currently employed at a university or other research institute in any European country except the UK. Fellows will receive a stipend of £2,000 per month, travel costs of up to £1,000 and research, support and training costs of up to £3,000.

The fellowships will support researchers who are relatively early in their research career and who are currently employed in academic positions (first academic post, tenure track position or independent research fellow) at a university or other research institute in any non-UK EU or EEA country.

Applications are encouraged which support links with our partner universities in the EUTOPIA European University Alliance (Vrije Universiteit Brussel, the University of Gothenburg, l'Université Paris Seine, Pompeu Fabra University – Barcelona, and the University of Ljubljana)

Fellows must have less than 10 years postdoctoral experience (taken from the date given on the PhD certificate to the start date of the Fellowship).

The Fernandes Fellows must remain in the employment of their home institution during the Fellowship and will have Academic Visitor status at Warwick.

While there is no restriction on nationality, appropriate permission to work in the UK is required before taking up the Fellowship.

Applications cannot be submitted independently by the potential Fellow. Nominations and hosting of the Fellow are made permanent Warwick academic staff members (including probationary academic staff), who will also be responsible for the financial conduct of the Fellowship.

Fellows will receive;

➤ Informacije s področja vesolja

Potekal je prvi sestanek odbora za opazovanje Zemlje, na katerem je bil narejen pregled stanja po ministrski konferenci. Glede na dober izkupiček na ministrski je vladalao precejšnje zadovoljstvo, kljub temu pa program Future EO ni bil 100% pokrit. To pomeni, da določene aktivnosti, ki so bile predstavljene v okviru programa, ne bodo izpeljane. Med DČ je bilo precej podpore novim vsebinam (AI, strojno učenje itd). Kot pogrešljive vsebine je bila največkrat izpostavljena EO4Africa, še posebej zaradi novega programa GDA, ki je namenjen predvsem aktivnostim na področju Afrike in Azije. Nekoliko vprašljive so lahko tudi aktivnosti povezane z HAPSi. Skoraj gotovo bo financirana samo ena Scout misija. DČ smo vabljene, da tudi pisno podamo svoje ideje glede aktivnosti, ki bi jih lahko pogrešili oziroma za katere se nam zdi nujno potrebno, da so izvedene.

Predstavljeni so bili tudi rezultati ITT za ScoutMission, izbrane so 4 misije, septembra 2020 se bo izbral eno misijo, ki bo razvita. Predstavljeni so bili tudi rezultati Open Call v okviru EOEP5. ➤ **Pregled industrijskih raziskav in razvoja za leto 2019**

Evropska komisija je konec decembra izdala "Pregled industrijskih raziskav in razvoja za leto 2019" [2019 Industrial R&D Investment Scoreboard](#). Podjetja v Evropski uniji so že deveto leto zapored povečala vlaganja v raziskave in razvoj (RR), vendar pod globalno stopnjo rasti. V letu 2018 so v raziskave in razvoj vložili 4,7% več. To rast vodijo avtomobilski, zdravstveni in IKT sector.

Ob vse večji svetovni tehnološki dirki je najboljših 2500 industrijskih igralcev po vsem svetu lani povečalo naložbe v raziskave in razvoj za 8,9%. 17 od 50 najboljših vlagateljev v raziskave in razvoj prihaja iz EU. Rast naložb podjetij s sedežem v EU pa so prehiteli ameriški in kitajski kolegi: prvi so lani povečala naložbe v raziskave in razvoj za 10,3%, drugi za 26,7%.

➤ **The ESPON 2020 Programme – What happened in 2019 and perspectives for 2020**

Potekal je prvi sestanek odbora za opazovanje Zemlje, na katerem je bil narejen pregled stanja po ministrski konferenci. Glede na dober izkupiček na ministrski je vladalao precejšnje zadovoljstvo, kljub temu pa program Future EO ni bil 100% pokrit. To pomeni, da določene aktivnosti, ki so bile predstavljene v okviru programa, ne bodo izpeljane. Med DČ je bilo precej podpore novim vsebinam (AI, strojno učenje itd). Kot pogrešljive vsebine je bila največkrat izpostavljena EO4Africa, še posebej zaradi novega programa GDA, ki je namenjen predvsem aktivnostim na področju Afrike in Azije. Poleg 301 raziskovalcev v sredini kariere, ki so v letu 2019 prejeli ERC Consolidator Grants, je ERC danes razglasil še 17 zmagovalcev z rezervnega seznama tega tekmovanja. Prejeli bodo finančna sredstva v vrednosti do dveh milijonov EUR na projekt za izgradnjo lastnih raziskovalnih skupin in uresničevanje njihovih najboljših idej na mejah znanja. Skupaj bo 318 raziskovalcev tako prejelo približno 635 milijonov EUR.

Donacije za konsolidatorje ERC se podelijo izjemnim raziskovalcem katere koli narodnosti in starosti, z najmanj sedem in do dvanajst let izkušenj po doktoratu, in z velikim znanstvenim potencialom. Raziskave morajo potekati v javni ali zasebni raziskovalni organizaciji s sedežem v eni od držav članic EU ali pridruženih državah. Sredstva (v povprečju dva milijona EUR na donacijo) so zagotovljena do pet let in večinoma zajemajo zaposlitev raziskovalcev in drugega osebja za konsolidacijo štipendistov.

➤ **ERC objavij informacijo o svojem predhodnem načrtovanju razpisov za 2021–2022**

Evropski raziskovalni svet (ERC) je objavil informacijo o svojem predhodnem načrtovanju razpisov za predloge 2021–2022. Prizadeva si za nemoten prehod ERC na Obzorje Evropa (2021–2027). ERC v svojem zapisu predstavlja tudi prilagoditve, ki so del širšega postopka razmišljanja in prilagajanja, ki vključuje znanstveni svet in izvršno agencijo ERC.

Po navedbah ERC naj bi se vsi razpisi z enim upravičencem (Starting, Consolidator, Advanced Grants, PoC) začeli izvajati v letih 2021 in 2022, vendar se bodo njihovi datumi odpiranja in zapiranja premaknili tako, da se bodo prvi razpisi začeli izvajati januarja 2021. Znanstveni svet pričakuje, da se bo urnik razpisov vrnil na običajne časovne okvire za odpiranje in zapiranje do sredine 2022.

Spremenjeno načrtovanje najbrž ne bo vključevalo razpisa za donacijo za sinergijo v delovnem programu ERC 2021. Ta razpis bo verjetno ponovno vključen v delovni program 2022. Namen znanstvenega sveta je, da ta razpis začne poleti 2021 z rokom novembra istega leta. Pričakuje se, da kakršen koli premik v urniku razpisov ne bo vplival na obdobja upravičenosti kandidatov, ki se prijavijo na zagon ERC Start in Consolidator Grants.

Znanstveni svet ERC prav tako uvaja dva nova področja, enega o "človeški mobilnosti, okolju in vesolju" in o "Inženiring materialov". Nova struktura panela bi morala biti vzpostavljena leta 2021. Postopek ocenjevanja dodelinih donacij ERC je treba uskladiti s postopki, ki se uporabljajo za razpise za začetne in konsolidacijske donacije, tako da se v 2. koraku ocenjevanja uvedejo razgovori prosilcev.
