1. Position:

HIGHER EDUCATION TEACHER – m/f
at the Department of Textiles, Graphic Arts and Design
job code: D019001
title: assistant professor/associate professor/professor
permanent employment, part-time (20 hrs/week)

2. Requirements for the position:

- a) Required education (level and field): doctoral degree (PhD) in the field of technology.
- b) Valid habilitation title at the University of Ljubljana: assistant professor or associate professor or professor in the field of information and graphic arts technology or electrical engineering or textiles or textile and clothing design or artistic expression in the field of textile design,
or meeting the requirements for the appointment to the habilitation title. In this case, the candidate is required to submit together with the application also the documents confirming the compliance of quality and quantity criteria for the appointment to the title or title recognition in accordance with the Criteria for Appointment to the Titles of University Teacher, Researcher and Associate at the University of Ljubljana. Moreover, the candidate should enclose a statement of agreement that in case the commission decides so, their application is treated at the same time also as the application for the appointment to the title or title recognition. The title must be obtained prior to the conclusion of the employment contract.
- c) Functional skills and other requirements:
 - rhetoric abilities, innovation, ability to organise own work and the work of colleagues, ability to lead groups and work actively with students,
 - knowledge of past and mostly current field of surface functionalisation,
 - knowledge of production procedures of packaging materials with different technologies,
 - knowledge of current contents in the field of planning and design of packaging,
 - ability to manage software for planning and design of packaging products,
 - active knowledge of the Slovenian, English and/or German languages at the level C2 according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages, as well as of the Croatian or Serbian languages, respectively, at the level B2.

3. Short work and assignment description:

- forming and updating the syllabus, and adjusting university and higher education study programmes to the requirements,
- organising and co-organising the activities for the implementation of courses in accordance with the syllabus and expert findings, coordination of work and supervision of other course teachers (assistants, technical staff and other co-workers),
- giving lectures to students, managing seminars and other pedagogical activities at courses in undergraduate and postgraduate study programmes,
- managing, correcting and grading exams and tests,
- directing students' research work and study activities, and mentoring students at the execution of their diploma and masters theses, and other works,
- scientific-research work, study and development of concepts, theories and methods,
- cooperation at other activities related to pedagogical or scientific-research work in the field of expertise (e.g. nostrifications, expert opinions etc.),

- taking care of safe and healthy work for colleagues and students at the unit, ensuring appropriate education and training for colleagues who come into contact with dangerous substances, using personal protective equipment and paying attention to other safety measures,
- performing other tasks which fall within the scope of the wider professional field of the workplace.

The application should include:

- curriculum vitae, incl. the description of previous work experience and a list of functional skills,
- bibliography, proof of education, proof of appointment to the title.
