Course progression requirements

Progression from one year to another:

- approved previous year of studies, i.e. course attendance for all courses in the previous year. Other progression requirements are the following
- for progression to the second year of studies: 48 ECTS collected.

The Study Commission of NTF may exceptionally approve progression to a higher year if the student has obtained minimum 30 ECTS in the previous year and can provide a sufficient cause. Sufficient causes are defined by the Statute of the University of Ljubljana.

According to the Statute of UL, a student may repeat the year if he/she has obtained 30 ECTS required for that particular year.

During the course of studies, a student can repeat the year once or once change a study programme due to failing to meet programme conditions in the previous programme.

After the second year, a student may, according to the statute, extend his/her student status for maximum one year if there is a sufficient reason for that and provided that the student has completed all obligations from the first and second year of studies.
