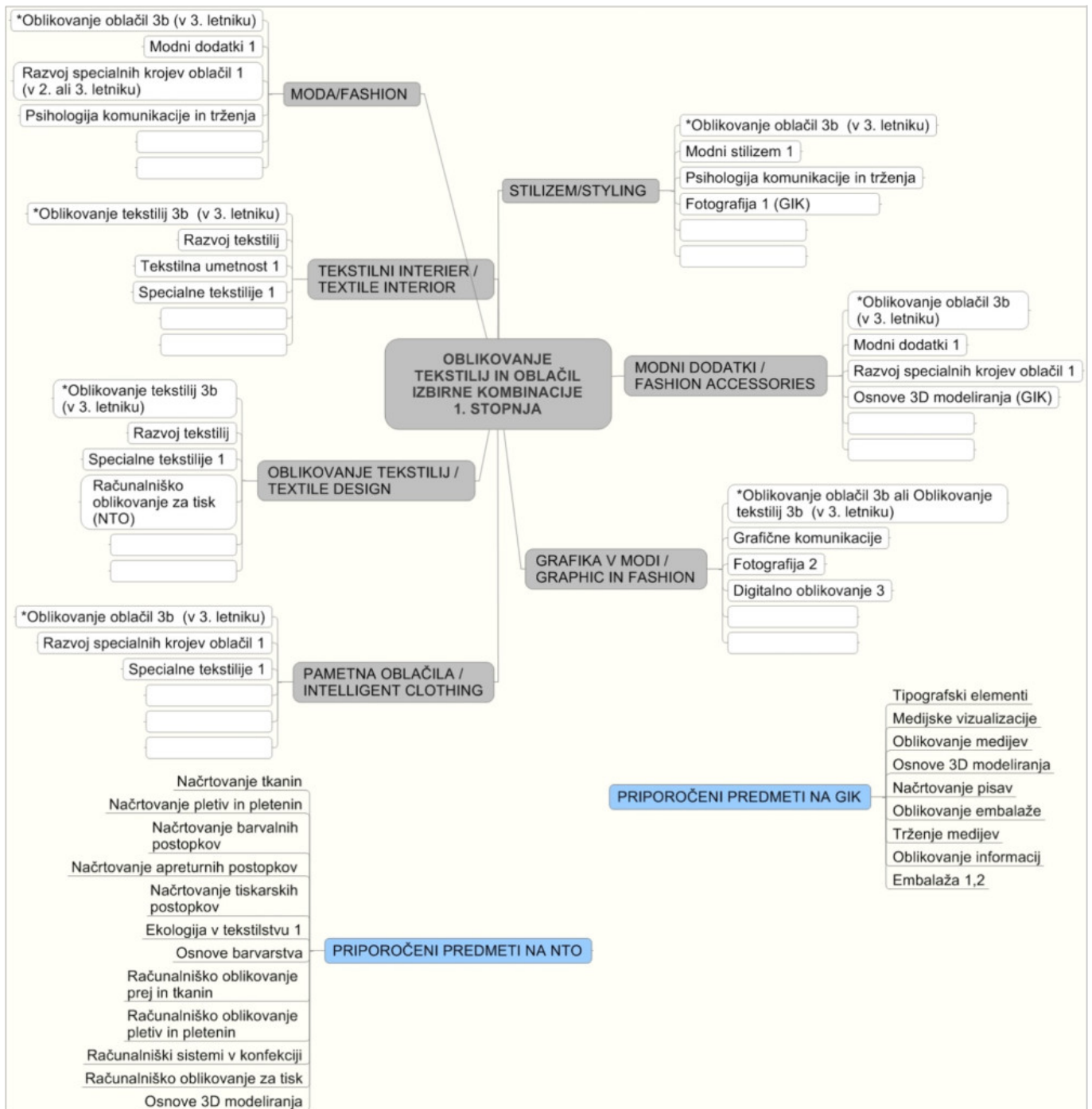

Recommended course combinations

These recommended combinations were drawn up in order to allow students to better take advantage of integrated Bologna programmes, thus giving students additional specialised knowledge in the areas they are most interested in and would like to pursue further.

Individual combinations, such as Fashion, Styles, Fashion Accessories, Textile Design, Interior Textiles, Fashion Graphic Design and Smart Clothing, represent a set of well-chosen combinations of complementary electives.

Students need to acquire $6 \times 4 = 24$ ECTS (credits) with these electives. Students may select their own combination of 6 electives within the pre-existing TCD programme; it is recommended the student select four or five subjects from the set; the others may be selected based on their preferences.
